### Executive Director's Corner

Greetings all,

Things continue to percolate at the Austin office, and I know the same is the case for you and your organization. In the January newsletter, I provided some bullet points regarding updates on current projects, meetings around the state, and the association's newly-awarded SAFER Grant. I'll continue with that format to provide additional updates:



- **SFFMA Portal:** The next module of the SFFMA Portal is slated to launch within the next few weeks, which will include the always important feature for submitting completed training for members. We've received a lot of feedback regarding the need to get the training submission feature launched as quickly as possible, so that is the priority at this point. When launched, members and department administrators will also be able to view their records of completed training and of certifications earned. The ability to request/schedule needed tests and to obtain additional certifications will follow soon after this launch.
- **Annual Membership Renewal:** Please bear in mind that we have changed how renewal happens each year with the SFFMA Portal. In the past, membership invoices were mailed to departments...that is no longer the case. However, the process is very easy and convenient: A department administrator logs into their account and chooses to manage the department, reconciles their roster as needed, and follows the instructions for renewing the department and personnel desired. Payment can be made online, or the administrator can print/mail the invoice with payment. ***Please help us continue to get the word out regarding the above change.***
- The association held what was considered by all to be a successful **Leadership Symposium** at the end of January. Attendees saw it as a valuable venue, and we will plan additional symposiums for the future.
- Please see the information on the SFFMA website regarding our current **SAFER Grant**. It's structured to assist departments with a number of needs that were not included in the previous grant.


Good luck with your departments' planning for the new year and with spring district meetings. Your executive board will do its best to attend those meetings to provide updates and receive important feedback from you.

## Certification Update

We are days away from launching the ability for departments to report and track training objectives through the new Portal database. Shortly afterwards, we will make the rest of the training/certification module active allowing upload of course completion certificates and submission of fees.

As with any project of this nature, we do not want to give a firm date as any unforeseen problem can delay the launch. Another big change with this program: we are doing away with the need to file actual signed application forms. Once all prerequisites and training are marked complete with training entered and validated, certifications that do not currently require an examination can be issued automatically upon payment of the fee. At this same point, certifications which require testing will prompt for written exam registration.




